Admittance to Calf Pasture Beach and Other City Parks

All Norwalk residents and property owners who pay vehicle tax to Norwalk have free vehicle admission to city parks such as Calf Pasture Beach.

If you have a rental vehicle, you must provide the rental registration along with proof of residency by providing one of the following:

- Current home lease/mortgage or property deed listing the Norwalk address and resident's name; or
- Current City of Norwalk vehicle tax bill

A valid pass for a rental vehicle will be issued for the dates provided in the rental agreement.

To obtain a valid resident pass for a company vehicle, you must provide the following:

Documentation from your employer on company letterhead stating that you are the sole driver of the vehicle;

- A pay stub from employer who provided the above letter; and
- Proof of residency in Norwalk

If residents and/or real property owners are more than forty-five days delinquent on their vehicle tax then this pass shall become invalid until the vehicle tax, and all applicable fees, interest and penalties, have been paid.

If you do not pay any vehicle tax to Norwalk, you may purchase a resident pass to the Norwalk public park system for a sum.
